



INTRODUCTION

Send Portions to them for whom nothing has been prepared!

The Christmas season is a time of great joy and celebration. It is the season to celebrate the birth of our Lord and Savior Jesus Chris. It is indeed a time to "••• eat the fat and drink the sweet…", but the Man of God, Pastor Chris Oyakhilome admonishes us to do something more, "send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared".

Nehemiah 8:10b [NLB] says '.....go and celebrate with a feast of rich foods and sweet drinks, and share gift of food with people who have nothing prepared.'

1.) WHAT IS SEND PORTIONS CAMPAIGN?

Launched during the yuletide of 2008, the **Send Portions Campaign** is a special feeding outreach to children in the inner cities. This has so far been conducted in over 100 inner city communities all over Lagos and in cities across Nigeria and in parts of Africa.

In addition to feeding children in inner cities, we visit orphanages, hospitals and related institutions that cater for children in need and also distribute Food Boxes to needy families with children living in very poor conditions.

2.) WHAT ARE THE OBJECTIVES OF SEND PORTIONS CAMPAIGN?		
 To feed hungry children in inner cities, orphanages and related institutions that cater for children in need around us this Christmas. To give them special Christmas gifts and extend the excitement of the season. To minister to them the message of Christmas, the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ not just in word, but in deed. 		
3.) WHAT IS A "PORTION"?		
A "portion" represents the gift pack we give to every child we reach during the Christmas season. The pack will consist of the following:

4.) HOW MANY CHILDREN DO WE WANT TO REACH WITH SEND PORTIONS CAMPAIGN?		
SEND PORTIONS CAMPAIGN IS BIGGER AND BETTER!

5.) HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO SPONSOR A "PORTION"?		
It cost just N1,000 [\$3 or £2] to sponsor a portion to a child.		
This is primarily because working with partners like you; we expect to generate bulk supplies of food items and packaging items such as rice, chicken, food packs, nylon bags, water etc from specially organized Food Drive & Toy Drive Events for Send Portions subsidizing the overall cost.		
6.) HOW CAN YOU PARTICIPATE IN SEND PORTIONS?

7.) HOW DO YOU GET STARTED?		
 Determine the number of portions your church / group / zone would like to sponsor and communicate same to the InnerCity Mission Send Portions Coordinating Office. Pick a Suitable Date to launch the campaign in your Church (preferably 1-2 weeks before the distribution date in the community you are sponsoring portions to) The InnerCity Mission Coordinating Office would work with your team to develop and dispatch publicity materials to publicize your campaign and execute the launch.

PREPARING FOR YOUR SEND PORTIONS LAUNCH

P	iblicize four Event: IN CHURCH
	Make regular announcements and play the Send Portions promo at Church Services and in specialized group meetings.
	Be sure to include in the announcements the ways your church is participating in Send Portions and encourage the brethren to get involved in all activities.
	Place Customized Send Portions Banner in your Church Venue and on-stage to keep
	the campaign in front of the brethren. Ensure that you have booklets of the special "Send Portions Vouchers" and get the brethren to sponsor as many portions as possible; at least every member to sponsor a portion each time the announcements are made. Vouchers should be available at the
	Partnership Stands and Church Office for brethren to purchase ahead of launch date.
	You can also give group targets depending on the complexity of your structure.

	Engage the Media in your locality to get the word out about the Ministry's laudable venture in reaching out to indigent Children through Send Portions Campaign.
	Hold a Press Conference and invite local print media, TV and Radio houses.

FIRST THINGS FIRST

HOW DO YOU IDENTIFY AN INNER CITY COMMUNITY?

The inner city settlements are constantly on the rise in most major cities of the world as a result of the rural/urban migration, communal crisis/wars and the search for the Golden Fleece.

The inner city by definition is the central area of a major city or metropolis, the term is often applied to the poorer parts of the city center and is sometimes used as a euphemism of being a residential area, perhaps a ghetto or a slum where residents are

less educated and more impoverished and where there is more crime.

By extension, slums, ghettos or shanty towns are also inner cities.

A slum is a run-down area of a city characterized by substandard housing and squalor and lacking in tenure security. They are usually inhabited by the very poor or socially disadvantaged. Slum buildings vary from simple shacks to permanent and well-maintained structures. Most slums lack clean water, electricity, sanitation and other basic services.

Ghetto refers to a neighborhood based on shared ethnicity by contrast, identification of an area as a slum is based solely on socio-economic criteria, not on racial, ethnic, or religious criteria.

A shanty town, also called a squatter settlement, is a slum settlement, sometimes illegal or unauthorized of impoverished people who live in impoverished dwellings made from scrap materials: often plywood, corrugated material, and sheets of plastic. Shanty towns often do not have proper sanitation, electricity, or telephone services.

DECIDING ON THE ORPHANAGE, CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL OR OTHER INSTITUTION TO VISIT

For orphanages, we suggest you visit on Christmas or Boxing Day; do note that for most of such organizations/institutions, you will need to book ahead and let them know you are coming on the appointed day.

How do you ensure you pick the right institution to visit? Simply as the following questions:

	ls it a government/privately-run organization?
	Will you be allowed direct access to the children?
$\bar{\square}$	Do they have genuine and apparent needs?
	Can you adopt the orphanage and make them the subject of regular ministrations?

For the orphanages, you might want to add other gifs to the "portion" that can help with daily life in the home such as a fridge, deep freezer, washing machine, generator etc; all depending on the need.

HOW DO YOU IDENTIFY FAMILIES TO RECEIVE FOOD BOX PORTIONS?

You can identify such needy families in one of two [2] ways:				
	By the recommendation of your brethren As a result of scouting in poor communities around your city.			

You must ensure you have the data of these families because more often than not, you will need to keep them on support till they can stand on their own and one vital ingredient is to make it mandatory that they get immediately involved in Church and in the Cell Ministry.

HOW DO YOU "SEND" YOUR PORTIONS?

in your catchment area, town, city or state and decide on your Send Portion locations
and estimate how many children you will reach in each location.
We advise that you work with the church ministry structure (Zone-Groups-Satellite Churches) existing in your church for effective distribution.
Design a period in December to send the portions to "those for whom nothing have been prepared".
For meaningful impact, you need to locate a community or settlement where you can feed at least 500 children.
Identify the head of the community simply by asking the residents and let him know what your plans are; once it is food for children, they are usually more than willing.
Your team must conduct at least two [2] outreach visits to this community before the said date. During these visits, you should visit the homes/dwellings and invite the
children for the outing. It is important to get the consent of the parents/guardians. Within or just walking distance to your target community, get a good location for
your food kitchen outing:
- It should be big enough to accommodate a crowd of 500 - 1000 standing children depending on your target.
 It should be easily accessible to other parts of the community.
- Residents should be able to see the meeting venue from their homes.
- Make arrangements for canopies and chairs.
 Hang your Send Portions banner on your canopy and keep your portions in the shade.
- Set up a PA system, keyboard and amplifier at the venue.
- Send out your team in two's or three's into the homes to share the word, give out Rhapsody of realties and send the children out to the venue.
- As the children arrive at the venue, organize them into neat rows like you would find in a Primary School.
- Assembly Ground Officials should be able to pass through the rows to facilitate interaction with the children as well as food distribution

☐ Set up a team that is charged with the responsibility of conducting feasibility studies

- Once you have ten [10] to twenty [20] children on ground, begin praise and worship using popular charuses. Be careful to have those who are used to children

☐ The time of fellowship should last about one [1] hour and should include an altar

call then the distribution of portions begins. Adults are not allowed at the fellowship venue, you must insist they drop the children and go back home or wait nearby.
